# GENDER JUST CLIMATE SOLUTIONS AWARDS

A global recognition spotlighting inclusive, gender-responsive climate solutions. Over 10 editions, it has demonstrated that placing gender equality and women's rights at the heart of climate action delivers transformative, lasting impact.

Awardees receive a monetary prize, access to the UN Climate Conference (COP), tailored mentoring and skills training, and international visibility through publications and high-level events.

## AN AWARD PROMOTED BY NGOS, ECOFEMINISTS AND WOMEN ADVOCACY GROUPS

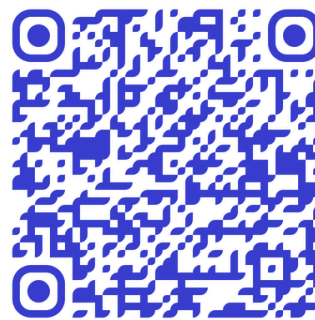
The GJCS is organized through a collaboration of key international actors:

- Women and Gender Constituency (WGC), a coalition of 64 NGOs established in 2009 with official UNFCCC observer status since 2011 and leading the program.
- Women Engage for a Common Future (WECF), which coordinates the awards and mentoring program, and has a global ecofeminist network of 250 organisations across 70 countries.
- Women's Environment & Development Organization (WEDO), a global women's advocacy organization that serves as the GJCS scale-fund coordinator.
- Climate Technology Centre & Network (CTCN), the UNFCCC's technical partner hosted by UNEP, providing expertise, technology support, and capacity-building for climate-resilient development.
