## Achievements



Identified the **real challenges** related to resource depletion faced by **10 women farmers**.



**Training sessions** for women farmers on **ecological transition** aligned with national and international strategies, emphasizing the importance of maintaining a strong **gender perspective** in these discussions.



**Mapped the impact** of climate change to their farm land and the development of guidelines for ecological transition based on these results and in alignment with national strategy.



**Green lab model** implemented where they developed a sustainable agricultural prototype with one farmer as a model for **ecological transition**.
