## CFLEDD - Dorothee Marie Lisenga



**Challenge**  
Structural gender inequalities in access to land rights



**Example Outstanding Outcome**  
Granting women access to land through the adoption of groundbreaking new land and forest legislation in 8 provinces of the Democratic Republic of Congo - mapping of 1.600 ha of land owned by women recognized by local authorities

## YAKKUM Emergency Unit - Anastasia Maylinda Titilestari

**Challenge**  
Share of public funding to adaptation efforts must reach 50% of the promised \$100bn pledge yearly AND COP 26 must take adequate and needs-based action on Loss and Damage (L&D)



**Example Outstanding Outcome**  
Empowers women thanks to a context-based adaptation project introducing aquaponics systems and the integration of women in national disaster-risk management.

## CAMGEW - Sevidzem Ernestine Leikeki



**Challenges**  
Patriarchal norms and gender stereotypes still prevail - Exclusion of women from decision-making spaces and resources management institutions - Lack of gender-responsive climate funding



**Example Outstanding Outcome**  
5 honey cooperatives were founded, as well as 100 MSMEs that support a unique scheme of social entrepreneurship. Women have control over the entire value chain, while strengthening their communities' resilience

## Union des Coopératives des Femmes pour la production d'huile d'Argan - Jamila Idbourrous

**Challenges**  
Women are still prevented to lead in the RE sector - Unequal distribution of care work



**Example Outstanding Outcome**  
600 rural women were trained in solar technologies and actively participate in the climate mitigation policy of their region, creating jobs that strengthen women's economic and political empowerment

## ENDA Colombia - Maria Victoria Bojacá Penagos

**Challenge**  
Lack of gender-responsive climate funding, appropriate laws and frameworks, and organisational support



**Example Outstanding Outcome**  
ENDA Colombia developed a holistic urban concept in the south suburbs of Bogota with climate-resilient gardening, responsible consumption and the formal recognition of women recyclers as environmental agents of change and public service providers.
