This time **10 children** were able to visit Tbilisi. They took part in the International Conference "Women Leaders in Times of Challenge and War" but also had plenty of free time to enjoy themselves.



Together with a number of organisations, BSWC organized several **charity events** in Germany. During the events, the Children Want Peace project was presented with the intent of expanding the project's territory to the European Union. The events were attended by over 350 people.
