“The fountain on Haşdeu Street in Anenii Noi was built around the year 2005 to provide water, as at that time the street was not connected to the centralized network. Due to financial limitations, the fountain has not been maintained or cleaned since its establishment. With the support provided through the financial assistance in the mini-grants program, the street residents have renovated the fountain, carried out landscaping, cleaned the spring, and conducted water analysis.”

### Achievements



**25 girls and women** from various regions of Moldova participated in the "Sustainable Feminine Leadership" programme. The aim of this training was to **facilitate synergy** between the feminist and ecological movements for sustainable development.



Participants of the training session had the opportunity to participate in the competition for the **5 mini-grants** and receive **\$400 competition-based funding** to carry out activities in their local areas. Eleven applications for funding of local initiatives were received from which 5 mini-grants were selected and offered financial support.
